In our single malt selection, we have tried to represent the best of the 6 whisky producing regions of Scotland

CAMPBELLTOWN

Springbank 10 Year£5.15
Springbank's 10 year old uses lightly peated barley to deliver a full-bodied taste & rich character

ISLAY

Ardberg 10 Year£5.60
Representing the island of Islay is our smokiest, peatiest single malt. A very smoky start gives way to the natural sweetness of the malt to produce a delicately balanced whisky

ISLANDS

Isla Jura 10 Year£3.80
Just across the water from Islay is the Isle of Jura. Light & delicate with a warming honey finish, Jura is aged in ex-bourbon to give an oaky, caramel flavour

HIGHLANDS

Glenfarclas 10 Year£4.30
Gloriously smooth yet with the depth and finish you would normally expect of a much older dram; a wonderfully sherried whisky with a vibrant straw gold colour

LOWLANDS

Auchentoshan 12 Year£4.30
Triple distilled then matured over 12 years, this lowland single malt whisky has the aroma of toasted almonds, caramelised toffee, delicate Auchentoshan taste

SPEYSIDE

Royal Lochnagar 12 Year£4.50
A favourite of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert, being conveniently close to Balmoral. the character here is grassy; think hay & straw. There is also a hint of cereal and a fresh, roasted spiciness
